### **Senate will consider the issue tomorrow Special Education at DE**

(SAN JUAN, Monday, Sept. 1, 2014) - The Committee on Education, Training and Development Guy Senate, chaired by Sen. Mayagüez-Aguadilla, Maritere Gonzalez meets tomorrow Tuesday at 10:00 am Rexach Bobby in the Hall, to see two resolutions relating to Special Education Program of the Department of Education.

Specifically, Senate Resolution 842 directs the Education Commission of the Senate "conduct a comprehensive research on the procedure followed by the Department of Education with and the students enrolled in the Special Education Program relocated to other schools due to the closure of its Site and the consequences that this has had on these students. "

The second resolution to be considered is the 846, which directs the Commission to investigate the use of funds appropriated to the Department of Education for school transportation concept to these students in Special Education.

To this view are confirmed presentations of the Council of Higher Education of Puerto Rico, the Steering Committee of Families of People with Disabilities, the Association of Parents of Persons with Disabilities, lawyers Brunilda Gonzalez and Jose Torres, who have legal cases of children education special as well as the Federation of Puerto Rico School Porters.

They are awaiting official confirmation from the Department of Education of Puerto Rico, the Teachers Association of Puerto Rico, the Teachers Federation of Puerto Rico, and educate the teachers' organization, as well as several organizations principals and school workers, among others.
